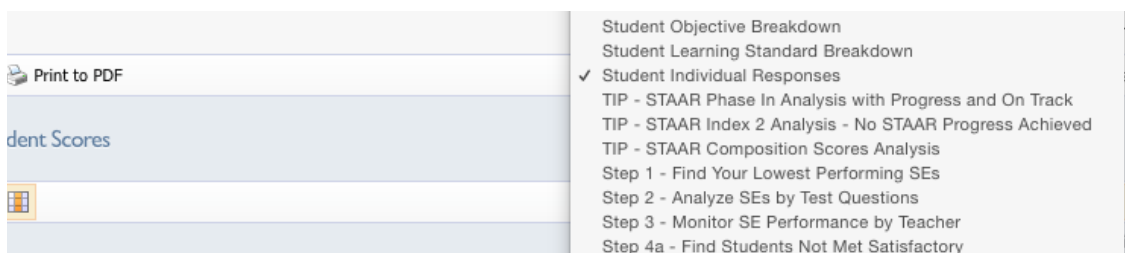
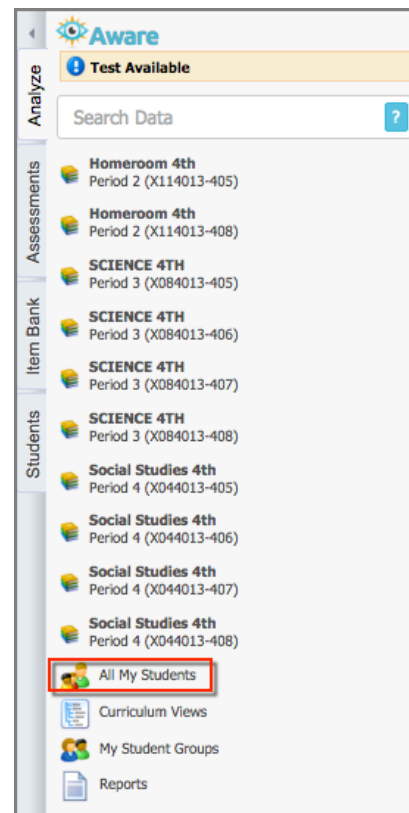
Pulling Assessment Data from Eduphoria

Pulling data from Eduphoria can be tedious because it takes one class and separates your class into multiple sections, one for general ed students and then other sections for LEP or Special Ed students, so for one class you may have multiple reports. Here is a quick guide to pulling the reports we will need to analyze data.

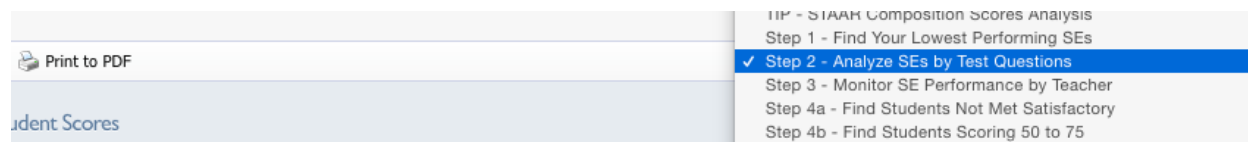
1. Login in to Eduphoria AWARE.

2. Click on Analyze then go all the way to the bottom and click All My Students. Then expand All My Students, test type, subject, year, grade level, and test. All the students who took the test will be displayed.

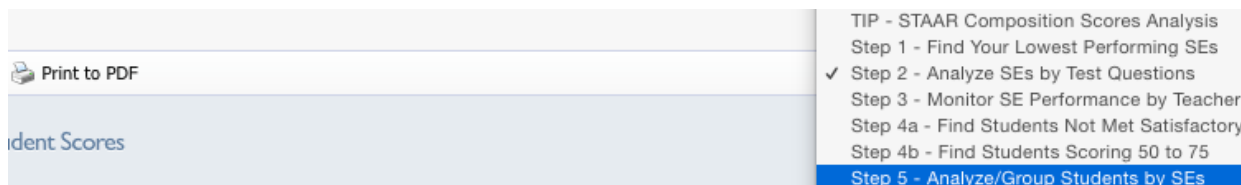
3. At the top right select the pull down and click on "Student Individual Responses. On the left click the icon Print to PDF and then print this data.



4. Then go to the same dropdown and click Analyze SEs by Test questions, this will show you what percentage of students got question correct, what percentage they answered a distractor item, and the objective number. On the left click the icon Print to PDF and then print this data.



5. Then go to the dropdown and click analyze/group students by SE. On the left click the icon Print to PDF and then print this data.



6. Use this data with the Data Tracker reteach guide in the reteach & data analysis folder to discuss reteach strategies for students that failed and the five most missed standards.
